GLAZE FINISH AWARNESS FORM

Thank you for selecting our fine cabinetry in a glaze finish. We want you to understand that there are some unique characteristics to a glaze finish.

Solid wood is one of our most cherished natural resources. Naturally occurring variations in grain and color are characteristics that give wood its' unique beauty. Many times, these naturally occurring variations remain visible with a glaze finish, and should be accepted as an inherent quality when selecting this type of finish.

The art of glazing begins with the application of a toner to enhance the wood's natural characteristics. The glaze is then hand-wiped over the toner, resulting in unique variances in coverage and saturation on cabinets throughout the room. Depending on the intricacies of the door style, the amount of glaze that settles in the grooves and corners of the door will vary. Also, areas on cabinetry such as fillers, valances, and exposed ends have no detail for the glaze to settle upon and therefore will be a slightly different color than the doors of the cabinetry.

Accordingly, all customer orders for a glaze finish must be accompanied by this letter of acceptance and agreement bearing the customer's signature.
